Year 1 Summer Newsletter

Dear Parents/Carers,

Our topic work for this term will be the adventures of Barnaby Bear. We will explore Chester, the Orkney Isles and Mexico. We will be comparing these places to where we live. We shall also be learning about weddings from around the world.



In our science lessons we will be experimenting with forces and exploring pushes and pulls. After this we will be learning about plants and investigating growing conditions.

This term the children are going to write their own stories about fantasy worlds. We will be working on developing their imagination and extending their vocabulary to make their stories interesting. We will be working on writing their own information texts and looking at a range of poems.



In Maths we will be extending the children's understanding of addition and subtraction and partitioning numbers into 10s and 1s. We will be counting in 2s, 5s and 10s, recalling doubles and near doubles and sharing objects equally. The children will be describing the features of 2d and 3d shapes, as well as using standard units to measure and compare length, weight and capacity. We will also solve problems using measures and continue to develop their concept of time.

This term we are going to make a natural collage and we will be using clay to make a sculpture. We are also going to use an art program to draw pictures on the computer.



In our music lessons we will be making and controlling long and short sounds using their voices and percussion instruments.

Our PE lessons are going to be outside games and athletics skills. The children will require PE kit suitable for outside activities and comfortable trainers/plimsoles. Please check shoes on a regular basis as the children grow so quickly. We are also looking forward to going swimming in the second half of the term.
